EXHIBITION DATES:

September 6-30, 2014

RECEPTION:

Sunday, September 14, 3 - 5 pm

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all artists who are current ACP members. Membership must be current through the duration of the show. Artists may join to enter (\$35 college students/seniors, \$45 indiv. and \$75 family). For more information visit artscouncilofprinceton.org.

SIZE AND MEDIUM: All works in painting, drawing, mixed media, photography, printmaking, ceramics, or sculpture are welcome. 2D works must not exceed 11"x 14" (including frame); 3D works must have a base no larger than 11"x

14" and be no taller than 14" (including base). Each artist may submit ONE piece and the work must meet the guidelines and BE READY TO HANG to be accepted for the exhibition.

SALES: The ACP will promote the sale of exhibited works and take a 30% commission from the selling price. (Artwork being for sale is not required.)

INSURANCE: Coverage begins upon physical acceptance of art at the Paul Robeson Center and continues for the duration of the show.

PROCEDURE: Artwork must be delivered to the Paul Robeson Center, 102 Witherspoon St., Princeton. All entries must be ready to hang and display. The ACP

reserves the right to reject any work that is not ready to hang or display in a professional manner. Works delivered by mail must include a stamped/self addressed parcel for return. A completed entry form must accompany the piece. Work will be accepted September 2 & 3, 10–4 pm

PICK UP WORK: All unsold work must be picked up on October 1 or 2 from 10–4 pm. Work remaining after October 5 becomes the property of the Arts Council of Princeton.
