

OFFICIAL RULES FOR THE ARTS COUNCIL OF PRINCETON 50/50 RAFFLE 2015

By entering the Arts Council of Princeton's ("ACP") 50/50 Raffle to be drawn at the Robeson Center for the Arts on May 9, 2015, each entrant (the "Entrant") accepts and agrees to these "Official Rules" including all eligibility requirements and decisions arising out of this Raffle by the ACP.

SPONSOR

This Raffle is promoted by the Arts Council of Princeton, a 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation, with an address at 102 Witherspoon Street, Princeton, NJ 08542. Federal Tax ID Number 22-6108090. This Raffle is being conducted pursuant to a raffle permit issued to the ACP by the Town of Princeton, New Jersey and the State of New Jersey. Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission ID Number: 406-5-36031. Municipality raffle license number: RL-0420

HOW TO ENTER

Raffle tickets are sold throughout a limited number of events at and by the ACP. During these events, Entrants may purchase Raffle tickets from authorized ACP staff, Board members and/or volunteers. The purchase price of Raffle tickets is \$5 for one (1) Raffle ticket. There is no minimum or maximum number of Raffle tickets that can be purchased by an Entrant.

No refunds will be given, and no replacement Raffle tickets will be provided. Raffle ticket purchases are not tax deductible for federal income tax purposes. At the time of purchase, a duplicate Raffle ticket will be collected and placed in a collection barrel.

Entrants who purchase Raffle tickets may opt to give away their Raffle tickets to others, but in doing so, they give up any claim they might otherwise have to the Prize if they surrender a winning Raffle ticket. Entrants may not re-sell their Raffle tickets to other parties and may not knowingly give such Raffle tickets away to others for the purpose of allowing those other parties to re-sell such Raffle tickets. All Raffle tickets which have been re-sold in violation of these Official Rules shall be void. All individuals who re-sell Raffle tickets in violation of these Official Rules shall be ineligible to participate in the applicable Raffle or win the Prize. Unauthorized sellers of a Raffle ticket are subject to prosecution.

The Arts Council of Princeton is not responsible and has no liability whatsoever for lost or stolen Raffle tickets, tickets damaged to the point of illegibility or tickets redeemed in error by its agents.

ELIGIBILITY

No one under the age of 18 years is permitted to participate in the Raffle, regardless of their state of residence. Raffle tickets must be purchased in person at the ACP sponsored events or directly by an authorized ACP representative.

No trustee or employee of the Arts Council of Princeton may participate in the 50/50 Raffle or be eligible for a prize.

The Arts Council of Princeton reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any Entrant for suspected or actual cheating and to prevent any person from participating in the Raffle or in the Prize award if that person does not adhere to the Official Rules or acts: (a) in a manner that the ACP determines to be not fair; (b) with an intent to annoy, threaten or harass any other person or the ACP; or (c) in any other disruptive manner.

RAFFLE IS VOID WHERE PROHIBITED. ALL FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS APPLY.

WINNER SELECTION

The winner will be chosen in a random drawing conducted by a representative of the Arts Council of Princeton in public from among all eligible entries received for the Raffle (the "Winner"). The drawing will be held at the Robeson Center for the Arts on May 9, 2015. The winner is not required to be present at time of drawing.

Odds of winning the Raffle will depend on the number of valid Raffle tickets sold.

All non-winning Raffle tickets will be forfeited.

The Arts Council of Princeton shall conclusively presume that the person possessing the winning Raffle ticket is the lawful owner of that Raffle ticket and that Raffle ticket's winning number, and the ACP shall not make, nor have any duty to make, any inquiry whatsoever into the circumstances under which that person came into possession of such

winning Raffle ticket. In the event that an error or problem in the administration of the Raffle results in two (2) or more Winners (whose Raffle tickets contain identical ticket numbers), the person who has record of the earliest ticket purchase shall be deemed to be the Winner.

PRIZE

For this Raffle, one (1) winner (the "Winner") will receive fifty percent (50%) of the proceeds from such Raffle (the "Prize"). The remaining fifty percent (50%) of the proceeds from the Raffle less expenses incurred that are authorized in the Raffles Licensing Law and the Rules of Legalized Games of Chance (the "Net Proceeds") will benefit the ACP's mission and programs.

PRIZE DETAILS

The Arts Council of Princeton shall have the sole discretion to determine whether the potential winner is the official Winner. The Prize will be paid by check to the Entrant within thirty (30) days of Entrant claiming such Prize. Any and all costs and expenses associated with Prize acceptance, as well as all federal, state and local income taxes are the sole responsibility of the Winner (including all IRS rules and regulations regarding gambling winnings and any other taxes or surcharges). The taxable value of the Prize will be treated as ordinary income to the Winner for federal and state income tax purposes. For security and safety reasons, no cash payments will be made to the Winner.

WINNER NOTIFICATION & REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

If not present during the drawing, the Winner will be notified by email and telephone no later than May 11th, 2015. The Winner must claim the Prize within ten (10) days of being notified. As a condition to receiving the Prize, the Winner must appear in person to the Arts Council of Princeton and provide the following required documentation: (1) proof of eligibility under these Official Rules; (2) the original winning Raffle ticket for such Raffle (no photocopies or other reproductions will be accepted and the winning numbers on the Raffle ticket must be visible, complete and legible); and (3) all tax identification information required by federal, state or local law. If the Winner fails to claim the Prize or provide the required documents, the ACP shall choose an alternate winner by the same method as the Winner. The ACP decisions concerning selection of the Winner, as well as all other matters relating to any Raffle, are final and binding.

PUBLICITY

To the extent permitted by law, each Entrant agrees that entry in the Raffle constitutes permission, in perpetuity, that the ACP and each of their respective, employees, officers, directors and/or members may use worldwide the Entrant's identity, name, image, likeness and biographical information, now or hereafter developed of Entrant's participation in the Raffle, for any purpose, including, but not limited to, publicity, promotional and advertising purposes related to such parties without any additional consideration or any compensation of any kind.

RELEASE

As a condition of entering the Raffle, Entrant agrees that: (1) under no circumstances will Entrant be permitted to obtain awards for, and Entrant hereby waives all rights to claim, punitive, incidental, consequential or any other damages, other than for actual out-of-pocket expenses; (2) all causes of action arising out of or connected with any Raffle, or the Prize awarded, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action; and (3) any and all claims, judgments and awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, but in no event attorney's fees.

LIABILITY

EACH ENTRANT: (1) ACKNOWLEDGES ACCEPTANCE OF THE OFFICIAL RULES AND AGREES TO ADHERE TO AND BE BOUND BY THEM; (2) ASSUMES ALL RISK, RESPONSIBILITY, AND LIABILITY FOR ANY PERSONAL BODILY INJURY OR DEATH OR ANY DAMAGE OR LOSS OF PROPERTY, INCLUDING ANY BODILY INJURY OR DEATH TO ANOTHER PERSON, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY ARISING FROM PARTICIPATION IN THE RAFFLE; AND (3) AGREES TO RELEASE, DISCHARGE, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS THE ARTS COUNCIL OF PRINCETON AND EACH OF THEIR RESPECTIVE, EMPLOYEES, OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, MEMBERS AND/OR VOLUNTEERS, THEIR SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, FROM AND AGAINST ALL CLAIMS, LOSSES AND DAMAGES TO PROPERTY OR PERSON, INCLUDING DEATH, INCURRED OR CAUSED BY ENTRANT OR ENTRANT'S REPRESENTATIVES, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, IN WHOLE OR IN PART, ARISING FROM OR IN CONNECTION WITH OR RELATED TO THE OPERATION OF, OR PARTICIPATION IN, THE RAFFLE.

The Arts Council of Princeton is not responsible for any printing, distribution or production errors and may rescind, cancel or revoke the Raffle based upon any such error without liability at the ACP's sole discretion.

The Arts Council of Princeton is not responsible for entries or payments that are delayed, misdirected, undelivered, not fully captured, or garbled as a result of any failure or problem whatsoever with the availability, functionality, operability or use of any network, server, Internet service protocol ("ISP"), website, computer, telephone, cable or satellite modem or connection, hand held mobile device or any other computer equipment or connection, whether or not caused by tampering, hacking, or by viruses, worms, or malfunctions affecting a network, server ISP or any equipment or programming used in or associated with the Raffle.

The Arts Council of Princeton is not responsible for any other errors whether human, typographical, printing, mechanical or electronic in nature, including any administrative error in connection with the Raffle.

ANY ATTEMPT BY AN ENTRANT TO DELIBERATELY UNDERMINE THE LEGITIMATE OPERATION THIS RAFFLE IS A VIOLATION OF THE OFFICIAL RULES AND OF CRIMINAL AND CIVIL LAWS. IF SUCH AN ATTEMPT IS MADE, THE ARTS COUNCIL OF PRINCETON RESERVES THE RIGHT TO SEEK DAMAGES FROM SUCH ENTRANT TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW.

The Arts Council of Princeton is not responsible for any inability to conduct the Raffle or award the Prize as a result of any act of God, labor stoppage strike, or lock out, or other reason beyond the control of the ACP.

GENERAL

The Raffle is conducted in the English language. The application and interpretation of the Official Rules and the award of the Prize shall be determined by the representatives of the Arts Council of Princeton, and all decisions in that regard shall be in the sole discretion of such representatives and shall be final and conclusive. Entrants agree that in the event a legal authority or insurer challenges the award of the Prize, the ACP shall have the sole right to determine whether or not to award such Prize. In the event of any claim or dispute with regard to the Raffle or the Official Rules, the laws of the State of New Jersey shall govern and apply, without regard to conflict of law provisions. Entrants agree to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of the State of New Jersey in regard to any claim or dispute with respect to any aspect of the Raffle or the Official Rules.

Under no circumstances shall a submission into a Raffle, the awarding of the Prize, or anything in these Official Rules be construed as an offer or contract of employment with the Arts Council of Princeton or its affiliates. Entrants acknowledge that their submission was voluntary and not in confidence or in trust. Entrants acknowledge that no confidential, fiduciary, agency or other relationship or implied-in-fact contract now exists between Entrant and the Arts Council of Princeton and that no such relationship is established by Entrant's submission under these Official Rules.
